- 8. I will use the computer, iPad, the Internet, email and other software for educational purposes. I understand all such use may be monitored.
- 9. I will not visit game sites that are not part of a classroom activity.
- 10. I will use only my passwords and will not share them.
- 11. I will not trespass in the files or folders of others.
- 12. I will use my files and folders on the server, on my device or in the Cloud responsibly. I understand my files and my personal electronic devices are not private. I am responsible for backing up my work. Teachers or administrators may see my files at any time.
