Motion was made by Kathy Brown seconded by Linette Miller to adopt the quarantine exemption guidelines as presented.

Motion passed: 6-0.

The following are recommendations from Kinsley-Offerle USD 347 and the Edwards County Health Department for quarantine guidance in schools.

If there is a close contact in the classroom and the positive case and exposed person are both wearing an approved mask correctly for the entire duration of the close contact, in general, the exposed individual(s)

may be exempted from a 14 day quarantine. Each situation will continue to be evaluated on a case by case basis by the school district and the Edwards County Health Department.

The following are important points to note:

- 1. This exception for quarantine is only applicable to COVID-19 and no other reportable infectious disease.
- 2. A close contact is defined as one who is within 6 feet for 10 minutes or more consecutively.
- 3. Exposure outside the classroom will still require a 14 day quarantine period.
- 4. Quarantine exemption does not include close contact situation that occur during athletic and other school sponsored activities.
- 5. Household contacts of any positive case must quarantine.
- 6. Any student or staff with a positive COVID-19 diagnosis shall be excluded from school for the length of their isolation.

This recommendation is made with the understanding that guarantine of all exposed individuals is the safest and most effective way to stop the spread of COVID-19 and exemption from quarantine will potentially put other community members, students and staff at risk for exposure.
